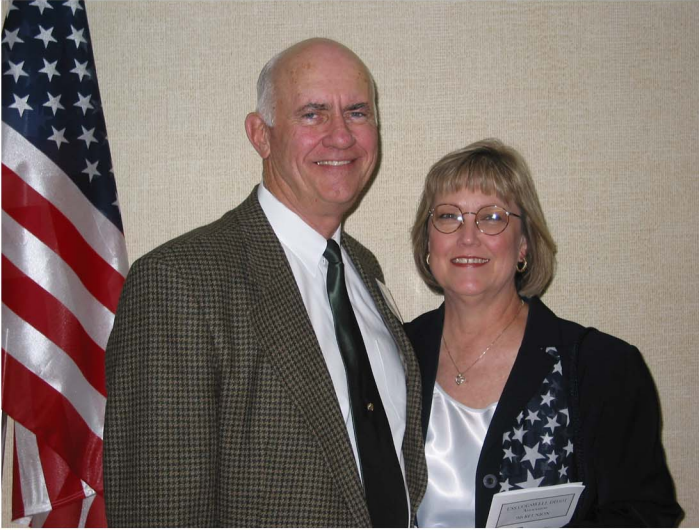

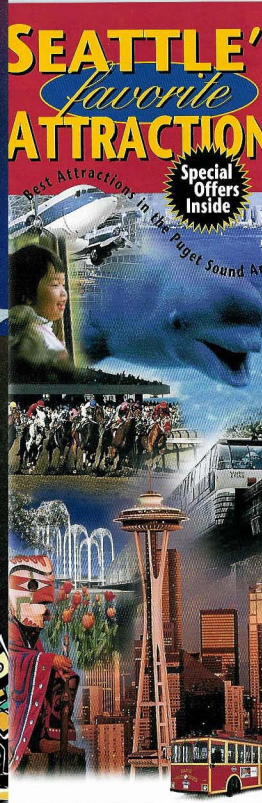

### ANCHORS AWEIGH! A LOOK AT OUR NAVY'S PAST & PRESENT

11:00 a. m. – 5:00 p. m.

Join our trip with a scenic cruise aboard a Washington State Ferryboat, Puget Sound to the Kitsap Peninsula. Our first stop will be the U.S.S. Ships Association, this Forest Sherman-class destroyer was constructed in 1942 and was decommissioned in 1982 after 23 years of Pacific Fleet service in the South Pacific, CA and was overhauled on three occasions at the Puget Sound Naval Shipyard. It was assigned to the 7th Fleet and saw extensive combat action during the Vietnam War where it was one of the Navy's "Top Guns" in the Pacific Fleet. Next, we'll enjoy a scenic cruise aboard Kitsap Harbor Tour's Motor Vessel Admiral Jack. While on board, we'll see the largest warship, the aircraft carrier USS Nimitz. Continuing on, our last stop will be at the Puget Sound Naval Shipyard Museum, established in 1954 by Rear Admiral Homer N. Wallin, USN, for preserving the history of the United States Navy. Our return ferry trip will conclude this fascinating day.

### SAMPLE SEATTLE - A DELUXE CITY TOUR

12:30 p. m. – 3:30 p. m.

Join us for a day, October 19, 2002. This tour provides an overview of the many attractions Seattle offers its visitors. We'll start in front with its import shops and fresh seafood restaurants, into historic Pioneer Square. This area features early 1900's architecture, much of which has been renovated into wonderful art galleries. Next is our International District, the third largest on the West Coast. Evidence of the Pacific influence is everywhere here, even the street lights have an Asian style. Continuing on, our first stop will be the Hillman Ladder. The locks are an engineering feat which connect saltwater Puget Sound with fresh water. The Almon Ladder features the seasonal migration of salmon returning to their parent streams to spawn at Squalia Bluff where the view of Puget Sound is breathtaking. This precedes your last stop, the world-famous Pike Place Market. Vendors from all around our region come to the market to showcase their wares. You'll have an opportunity to browse and hopefully find a perfect souvenir of your trip to the Emerald City.
