Room rates for all available rooms: \$79 per night plus tax (for up to two people in one bed rooms and up to four people in two bed rooms.) The room rate includes a breakfast buffet for guests in the hospitality room. The room rates are available throughout the period of 6/04-6/12. There is also a generous cancellation policy of 24 hours in advance so book early knowing that you can cancel up to 24 hours prior to check-in if last minute circumstances prevent you from attending.

On Tuesday morning at 0800 (sharp) the bus will be leaving the hotel at the front lobby for our approximate one hour trip to Mukilteo, WA to visit The Future of Flight Aviation Center and the Boeing factory tour.

Visit the Largest Building in the World (by volume)

Boeing Future of Flight is one of Seattle's most-loved, premier attractions. Located just 25 miles north of Seattle, the Boeing Tour is a one-of-a-kind opportunity to view 747, 767, 777, and 787 Dreamliners on the assembly line before they take to the sky.

The Boeing Factory Tour is a visit inside a working assembly plant, which can be noisy and active depending on the day and time. Employees on the Everett site, work 5 days a week, 3 shifts a day. Any employees on the weekend will be essential services or overtime; so please be aware that activity in the factory on weekends may be minimal.

Each tour is approximately 90 minutes long and includes fascinating facts about Boeing and the planes that bear its name.

Some things to consider before taking this tour:

- Walk up and down two steep flights of stairs at each end of the factory and walk through two large tunnels, the first 0.3 miles (0.5 km) round trip, the second shorter.
- Ride two freight elevators to balconies overlooking the Boeing factory floor.
- Special accommodations can be made for wheelchairs or physically challenged guests with advance notice. Please advise us if you or someone in your party is confined to a wheelchair.
- Service animals are allowed in all public areas of Boeing Future of Flight and on the Boeing Tour.
- There are restroom facilities and a café at the Future of Flight. Restrooms are *not* available during the Boeing Tour.

Restrictions:

- Children must be at least 4 feet (122 cm) tall to go on the tour. Visitors may not carry babies on the tour.
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult when visiting Boeing Future of Flight or to take The Boeing Tour.
- Please note that The Boeing Company does not permit still photos or video cameras on the tour. In addition, there are no personal items allowed on the tour, including purses, backpacks, waist pouches, binoculars, cell phones, etc. Free lockers are available onsite.

After the Boeing tour we will board the bus for a trip to Pike's Place Market in Seattle.



Pike Place Market is a public market overlooking the Elliott Bay waterfront in Seattle, Washington, United States. The Market opened August 17, 1907, and is one of the oldest continuously operated public farmers' markets in the United States. It is a place of business for many small farmers, craftspeople and merchants. Named after the central street, Pike Place runs northwest from Pike Street to Virginia Street. With more than 10 million visitors annually, Pike Place Market is Seattle's most popular tourist destination and is the 33rd most visited tourist attraction in the world.

We will spend approximately 2 1/2 hours at the market which will allow time for lunch in one of the many restaurants and shopping at any of the multitude of businesses present. Don't forget to stop by the original Starbucks in Pikes Place Market. We should be back to the hotel around 1500.

WEDNESDAY SIGHTSEEING JUNE 09, 2021

There will be no large group tour on Wednesday. What we would like to see is small groups gathering together with one person acting as Wagonmaster or tour guide. Groups can form caravans and visit many of the sites available in the area. Groups can be formed based on which sites each person would like to visit.
